Dear Ms. Powers,

Our firm has been engaged to represent Marge Puka (“Marge”). Reference is made to the lawsuit you filed against Marge on December 7, 2023 (the “Lawsuit”). The purpose of this letter is to advise you that if you continue to pursue the Lawsuit, my client will vigorously defend against such action and to put you on notice that if you continue the pattern of filing frivolous lawsuits against Marge, we will bring an action against you for abuse of process.

It appears that the Lawsuit seeks reimbursement for final accounting fees incurred for the Puka Private Annuity Trust (the “Trust”), in the amount of \$1,029.00. As an absolute threshold matter, such Trust has since been dissolved. As you are aware, you entered into Settlement and Agreement of Interested Parties Pursuant to the Idaho Trust and Estate Dispute Resolution Act (the “TEDRA Agreement”) which dissolved the Trust. The TEDRA Agreement was approved by the Court on December 23, 2022. Furthermore, it is believed that no accounting fees were ever incurred by the Trust. In fact, it appears that the amount you are seeking is for reimbursement of attorney’s fees that you incurred in the initial Trust dispute. However, any amounts owed to your attorney are between you and your attorney-not Marge.

I have further been made aware, from your blog posts titled Powers v. Puka, that you plan to continually file several lawsuits against Marge, as well as Charmelle Puka (“Charmelle”) and Janette Golay (“Janette”). Please be advised that if you continue to file frivolous lawsuits against Marge, Charmelle, or Janette, they are prepared to exercise any and all right available to them under Idaho law should you continue such conduct, up to and including commencing litigation against you for abuse of process. In such an event, my clients will seek injunctive relief,

recovery of all damages that she has suffered as a result of your conduct, as well as the attorney's fees and costs pursuant to Idaho law, including without limitation, Idaho Code §§ 12-120, and 12-121.

Marge remains cautiously optimistic that this letter may calm the hostilities among the family members, but be advised if it continues, Marge is prepared to take any and all legal action to defend against such continued hostilities.
